WASHINGTON LETTER.

The Panama Situation—Reciprocity with Cuba—The New Minority Leader—The Democrats and Chairmanships—Crum's Apportionment.

WASHINGTON, D. C., Nov. 12, 1903.—In all political and diplomatic circles here the Panama situation is the all absorbing topic of discussion. The new republic was born so quickly and the attitude of the administration announced so promptly that public men have hardly had time to catch their breath before being called upon to express their opinion on the affair. Declaring that "he is bound merely by treaty obligations but by the interests of civilization to see that the peaceful traffic of the world across the Isthmus of Panama shall not longer be disturbed by a constant succession of unnecessary and wasteful civil wars," President Roosevelt has issued a communication to our representatives in Panama and Colombia in which he says that the United States has entered into relations with the defunct government on the Isthmus. More ships are on their way to Colon and Panama and our government has informed Colombia that she will not be allowed to land troops at these ports. Mr. Philippe Bunau-Varilla has been appointed "envoy extraordinary and minister plenipotentiary to the government of the United States with full powers, to conduct political and financial negotiations." The new envoy has been received and dinner by Secretary Hay. He is talking negotiating a treaty direct with the United States. He began his career by what is regarded here as a "breach of diplomatic propriety," in writing an open letter to Senator Morgan asking the champion of the Panama route to renounce his opposition to Panama. He explains later

will succeed in defeating it, it is evident to a non-partisan observer that the reciprocity will be granted to Cuba either at the next session or during the first part of the regular session.

Owing to the selection as the leader of the democratic minority in the House, Representative John Sharp Williams of Mississippi has become one of the most prominent figures in the lower branch of Congress, where he has served his party for the last ten years. He is fifty years old, a lawyer by profession, but he is extensively engaged in cotton planting. He was educated in the University of Virginia and in Heidelberg, Germany. He speaks several modern languages, is a forceful speaker and logical debater and one of the most learned men in the House. He entered political life at the time of the Chicago convention which nominated Cleveland and Stevenson, when he was a member of the Mississippi delegation. Since that time he has always been elected to succeed himself, the last time getting every vote in his district. He now occupies the highest position in the House which is within the gift of the democratic party.

The republicans of the Senate have decided to remove Senator Morgan from the chairmanship of the committee of the Inter-oceanic Canals, and the Senate committee of committees has been instructed to choose his republican successor. It is no doubt owing to his determined hostility to the Panama route that the venerable senator from Alabama is to be removed. Senator Hanna, who is the strongest advocate of the Panama route and the third member of the committee, will probably be made chairman. Senator Morgan will be offered the chairmanship of the committee on Public Health and Quarantine, a position formerly held by Senator

VISIT TO OLD COUNTRY

Saw the King and Queen in Belfast—"Old Glory" in the Reception—Pleasant Visit to Relatives of Our People.

The next place I visited after Toome was Belfast the most populous city of Ireland. It has a population of about four hundred thousand. Belfast is beautifully situated on Belfast Bay, which gives it a fine harbor. One of the great industries of Belfast is ship building, which gives employment to thousands of laborers. The largest ship yard in the world was built in Belfast. Probably the largest industry in Belfast is the manufacture and sale of linen. There is also a large amount of cotton manufactured there.

I visited Rev. Samuel Lindsay and three sisters. He is a brother of our townsmen, Mr. Wm. Lindsay. He has now retired after spending many years of his life preaching in Ceylon. Here I met Mr. Harry Lindsay, who I understand was doing well. He made many inquiries about the people of Chester whom he remembered pleasantly.

I visited Mr. Wm. McCaughey and family who live in an elegant home a few miles out of Belfast. It is connected with the city by street car line. Mrs. McCaughey is a sister of Mr. H. McCandless. They have an interesting family of one son and five daughters. I visited the beautiful home of Mr. Jas. McCaughey a brother of Mr. Wm. McCaughey. A son of Mr. Wm. McCaughey visited Chester some time last year. He had taken home with him a few bags of corn. He had planted a few grains in a hot house and had about a half dozen stalks growing which was quite new to them. This was the only corn growing I saw in all my trip. The only potatoes, grapes, tomatoes and cucumbers I saw growing were in hot houses. Messrs. Jas. and Wm. McCaughey are engaged in a wholesale business. I visited Mr. John Harrison and family. He is employed by the Messrs. McCaughey. He lived with his uncle, Mr. H. McCandless for several years. He made many inquiries about the Chester people. He thinks he will probably return to his country to live at some future time. I visited a Mr. Priestly and family and his mother-in-law, Mrs. Craig, who is an aunt of Mrs. H. McCandless. I made them a short but pleasant visit. I take this opportunity to publicly thank Mr. Wm. Lindsay, Mr. H. McCandless, Mr. Robt. Millroy and Mrs. J. K. Coleman for letters of introduction to their friends and for letters written direct to them of my coming. These letters gave me an opportunity to visit their friends in their homes, which added greatly to the pleasure of my trip. Never before in my life have I had the pleasure of visiting a more kind, clever, Christian people. I shall always hold them in grateful remembrance for their kindness to me.

Before leaving home I did not have the most remote idea that I should see the king and queen of England. It so happened I was in Belfast during their visit there, which gave me the opportunity to see them. This was a great event in the history of Belfast. I saw the statement in a newspaper that this was the first time that a reigning king of England had ever visited Ireland. I heard that some other paper had contradicted this statement and claimed that one had been there two or three hundred years ago. I did not undertake to settle this matter, but it has undoubtedly been a long time since they had a visit from a king. The protestants almost to a man are very loyal to the king but the Catholics are as rebellious as ever.

The English government has been doing everything they could to conciliate and make loyal the people of Ireland. They look on Gladstone as their temporal savior. Gladstone had legislation passed by the English Parliament that was greatly in the interest of the ten-

ants of Ireland. Nearly the whole of Ireland is owned by a few landlords. There was a time when a landlord could demand any amount of rent he saw fit to ask and the poor tenant felt that he could, and very often he would eject him. I understand that sometimes he would be ejected and did not vote to please the landlord. This has all been changed now. The rent is now fixed by commissioners appointed by the Government. The consequence is, the rents have been greatly reduced from what they once were. During this year legislation was passed giving a tenant the right to buy the land he is living on. The Government will furnish him the money at a very low rate of interest and give him fifty years to pay for his land. By paying the interest and one fifth part of the purchase price of the land each year, he will own his land in fifty years. The protestants are very much opposed to home rule as they are in the minority and are afraid of the Catholic rule.

The royal session passed through about the middle of the city. A very subtle force was built just in front of the city hall. The streets the crowds did not keep back from interfering with the process. There was also inside of the city on both sides a line of men. I am all this the lord may have a proclamation on to be inside of these streets. I was in front of the city hall. I saw a lot of his mother-in-law. I also took part in the process of the Victoria Royal. It was a wonderful day. He had the decorations, along with the party passed.

More About Synod.
The report of the meeting of Synod in Winnsboro which is printed on the first page of this issue is incomplete, brief as it was intended to be, and we expected to add something to it before it was printed. Like most things that are deferred, however, what we shall add must also be incomplete.

The centennial exercises were intensely interesting. The addresses and sermons were of unusual excellence. We should like to make special mention of some of these, but in looking over the program, we are unable to find a number that could be passed over. We may be permitted to say that the address of Rev. J. S. Moffatt, D. D., on "What the Associate Reformed church stands for," was one of those that attracted most attention. One of the ablest men of our acquaintance pronounced it "masterly and magnificent. The most widely known editor in the state said, "He did himself proud; it was simply grand, especially the latter part." Another judge said, in private conversation arguing in favor of Bishop Doan's wider field, "A man who is capable of such a production as that delivered Saturday night ought not to be confined to the limits of a single congregation." And these are only samples.

With the local claim made upon Maj. J. C. Campbell, the News & Courier has commented to mention his paper on Scotch Irish Presbyterians in History," which was a gem, whether viewed as a literary production or with regard to the matter.

As to the business transacted at the meeting we can say but little. The most important matter considered was the question of union with the United Presbyterian church, which was overruled by the presbyteries.

Dr. J. S. Moffatt was asked to become joint agent of Erskine college and of the home mission work, though he positively declined, he was elected and urged to hold the matter under consideration until January.

A pleasant feature of the meeting was that in all the discussions—and some of them were quite animated—not an unkind word was spoken.

Dr. Gaston, whose death is announced in the press dispatch below, was a native of Chester county and an uncle of A. L. Gaston, Esq.
Atlanta, Ga., Nov. 15.—Dr. J. McGuffin Gaston died at his home here 79 years of acute indigestion, aged 79 years. He was prominent during the Civil war as a medical officer in the Confederate service. After the war, from 1865 to 1883, he made his home in Brazil, attaining distinction in his profession there. He returned to Atlanta in the latter year and has since that time been at the head of the department of surgery in the Southern Medical college here. He was an authority widely quoted in this country and Europe on intestinal surgery, and in the treatment of intestinal diseases he was the pioneer in several methods. He was a member of several medical societies, national and southern, in which he held high office.

President E. Miller Boykin and Cashier E. C. Zamp of the Farmers and Merchants Bank in Camden, both shot and killed themselves yesterday. It is claimed that Mr. Boykin's death was accidental, but Mr. Zamp's was planned a case of suicide. The bank is in condition that demands investigation.

There's proof abundant of it all over the United States. There soon be proof abundant of it in Chester.

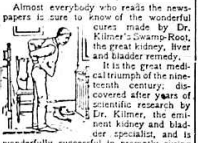

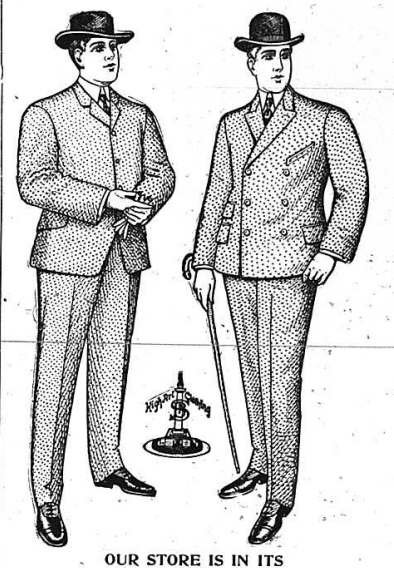

It Was Different.

The Orangeburg Patriot very pertinently asks why the Laurens jury that released Wham from custody for killing Ramage is not excoriated as was the Lexington jury. It seems to us to be just so, and so have other papers, but when we talk about the Wham case the readers of the paper do not know what we are talking about. They were not interested enough to learn the particulars or to read the evidence, therefore the lesson loses its force. That is why so much fuss is not made about it.

Unfortunately there are too many incidents that might be brought up to point out a moral, but there is but one that will be fully understood and so that one is used.

In classing the Lexington jury with the Laurens jury, the Orangeburg Patriot and the Florence Times seem to ignore the facts. In the Laurens case Wham established a clear case of self defence. He was in his own house where he had been followed, after his pursuers had been ordered out of his premises, and the man killed by Wham had a drawn pistol in his hand when shot, which was found under his body. Wham was on trial for the killing of his pursuer, and not for his misconduct which led up to the unfortunate affair. He deserves to be tried and seriously punished for that; but we do not understand that the indictment upon which he was tried included his immoral conduct which aroused his neighbors and brought about the unfortunate result.—Watchman and Southern.

Good Roads in the South.

We have called attention several times recently to the good work done in Louisiana in the matter of better roads, especially in Ouachita and Natchitoches parishes. A better feeling has been aroused throughout the state, and we may look for a continued improvement from year to year, that is, the more miles of good roads constructed the more clearly their value will be seen.

The chief difficulty in the south in building roads is the expense. The Southern counties have not the money to spend on expensive roads, however much they may be desired, as they have so many other heavy burdens on their hands, in the maintenance of the schools, levees, etc. If they are to do much in the way of road building it must be done cheaply.

South Carolina has been experimenting in this matter, and we learn from the Charleston News and Courier that it is doing splendid work in building good roads at small cost. Some of the facts and figures given by the South Carolina paper are most encouraging, showing that good roads can be constructed at a cost far below what we have been led to believe. Thus in Newberry county a road eight miles long was constructed at a cost of only \$350, the chain being used. It is claimed that this road is the cheapest ever constructed in the United States, and this claim will not be disputed. The Newberry road has been travelled from six to twelve inches thick. In Sumter county, where there is no gravel, good clay and sand roads are being constructed at a cost of \$800 a mile, including the material and all other expenses except the maintenance of the convicts employed.

If we can do in Louisiana anywhere near as well as South Carolina is doing in this matter, there is no reason why any portion of Louisiana should be without good highways.—New Orleans Times Democrat.
