Rachel Harris Brown was born April 13, 1920 in Oconee County, South Carolina. She was the daughter of George Lawrence Harris and Nellie Crawford Harris. She graduated from Winthrop College. Before World War II she taught at public schools in both North and South Carolina. During the War she worked as a cryptanalyst at the Pentagon in Washington, D.C.

Following World War II she worked as a receptionist and in 1948 she married Hugh D. Brown. They ran Brown's Funeral Home until 1991. They had four daughters and a son. Rachel passed away on June 12, 2007.
