Naomi Norris Stuart '44

Naomi Norris Stuart was born on July 24, 1924 in Piedmont, South Carolina. She attended and graduated from Duncan High School. She graduated from Winthrop College in 1944. Naomi worked as a cryptographer in Washington, DC during World War II. From 1945 – 1949 she worked in the office of the Honorable J.R. Bryson, Congressman from South Carolina.

Nomie returned to South Carolina in 1949 and worked for the law firm of Williams & Henry in Greenville until she married Charles K. Stuart on September 2, 1949. They had two children. Naomi died on September 2, 2014.
