BLUE RIDGE RAILROAD.

Mr. Editor: * * * To enable Tax
 Payers, and other citizens of the District,
 who may feel an interest in the project,
 to understand it, a brief history of the condition
 of the Baban Gap enterprise, at the time the
 bill was introduced, is presented to the public,
 and the present prospect, as far as possible,
 to give, together with the amount and character
 of assistance demanded from the treasury
 of this State.

The Blue Ridge Company was chartered
 in 1842, and the object had in view was to
 construct a Railroad from Anderson, C. H.
 in this State to Knoxville in the State of
 Tennessee, a distance of 190 miles—51 in this State, 143
 in Georgia, 74 in North Carolina, and 26 in
 Tennessee. Shortly after the charter was ob-
 tained the Company was organized, with the
 following as its members, to wit: A subscrip-
 tion on the part of the City of Charleston,
 in its corporate capacity, of \$100,000; a
 subscription on the part of private individ-
 uals of \$101,000; and a guarantee of the
 bonds of the Company by the State of a mil-
 lion and a quarter—amounting in all to
 nearly two millions and a half, estimating
 at that, the bonds as yet to be endorsed by
 the State. With such a guarantee, and in
 1853 the road was put under contract from
 one terminus to the other, Messrs. Auman
 Bangs & Co. having contracted to begin the
 work on the 1st of August, '54, and to finish
 and equip the road from Anderson to
 Knoxville within four and a half years from
 that period. What the precise terms of the
 contract were, I am not certain, but the
 contractors were to be paid partly in sub-
 scriber's stock and partly in bonds of the
 company in bonds of the State amounting to
 three millions.

The above part of the road is the most
 difficult of construction. It will be seen, by
 reference to the report of the Chief Engineer,
 G. B. Lythorn, issued in November, 1854, that
 as to the general features, estimating the
 cost of each section, the portion in the
 State of Tennessee is estimated to cost \$1,093,493
 exclusive of iron and rolling stock; that in
 Georgia \$92,914; that in North Carolina
 \$1,183,950; that in Tennessee \$1,115,512; 17,
 making about five millions and a half.
 Add to this the cost of the iron, of the ne-
 cessary cars and locomotives, and it could
 not fall much short of seven millions of dol-
 lars, taking the estimate of the engineers as
 the basis.
