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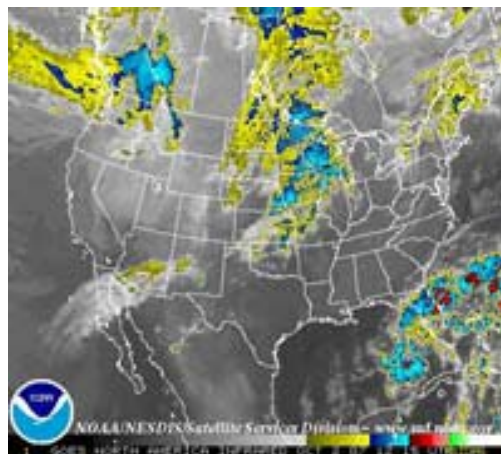

NOAA Celebrating 200 years of Service



Thomas Jefferson, in 1807, created the first federal scientific agency, *Survey of the Coast*, to support safe maritime commerce. The first *Weather Warning Service* was developed in 1870. It was followed by the first *Hurricane Warning System* which began service two years prior to the Galveston Hurricane of 1900.



Since then, various agencies and programs including *Coast and Geodetic Survey, World Weather Programs, U.S. Lake Survey Office, Pacific Halibut Commission* and other ocean and weather related offices and agencies joined to form what we know today as NOAA, the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, officially named in 1970.

NOAA provides weather forecasts, severe storm warnings, climate monitoring, fisheries management, coastal restoration, etc. and maintains one of the world's largest archives of oceanographic data.
