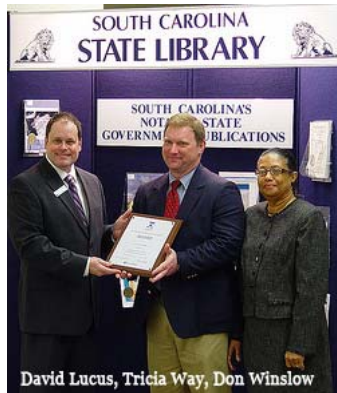

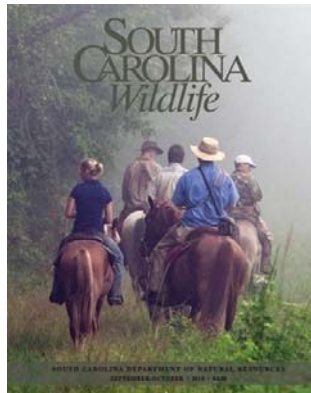
South Carolina 2010 Notable State Documents Awards
