Chester County's first bale of 1917 cotton was placed on the local market yesterday by Mr. J. G. L. White. The bale weighed 443 pounds and was classed as strict middle bringing 22 1/4 cents. It was bought by Joseph Willie & Co. At present there is no doubt but that the cotton crop throughout this section will be considerably below normal. The dry weather for the past few weeks has caused the stalks to shed a number of bolls. Many people are of the opinion that cotton will reach 35 cents this fall while others contend that it will reach 40 cents.

CHESTER DOING HER PART

The Rock Hill Record, in the following article, calls attention to the condition of the highway between Charlotte and Columbia.

There is no reason why the National Highway should not pass through Rock Hill and Chester. We assure our esteemed contemporary that Chester county is no doubt her part. Work of this road will shortly be commenced by the Chester County Highway Commission and we would suggest that our neighbors get busy with their part of the work.

The article follows:

"We would just like to give a little hint to the Chamber of Commerce of this city and of Chester, Fort Mill, Winstons and other places along the line—most especially, Fort Mill, Rock Hill and Chester. If they want to have a National Highway between Charlotte and Columbia through their respective cities that had better get busy on the matter and put it in some definite shape. The bridge across the Catawba between Rock Hill and Chester is a very old and in a bad way and the road from Rock Hill to Fort Mill will be in an elegant shape, and because of the Rock Hill and Chester road is good, but we understand, that there is points between Fort Mill and Charlotte, Chester and Rock Hill and Chester, and Winstons, that will have to be put in first class shape before this route can be considered for a national highway. The reason we say 'a little hint' is the fact that we note that a contract is to be let soon, or maybe has already been let, for a new bridge across the Catawba at Camden and this, if it is not cancelled will make the chances for the completion of the Rock Hill-Fort Mill road very slim. We believe that the matter is pushed right now on the eve of the completion of the Rock Hill-Fort Mill road. The bridge that is being considered is a final as the route this way would be much better, because it is a ridge road all the way and no streams after Chester is passed, and is also much shorter."

FIRST TO GO

The Chester county local exemption board has recently received instructions from the War Department to make preparations for sending five per cent of Chester county's quota of the National Army to the mobilization point. While the local board has not yet received official instructions to send Chester men to Columbia it is in a very active way. At the time that Camp Jackson is in operation which Chester men will be mobilized.

The men who are scheduled to go first will be mailed a card by the local board informing them that they have been selected and also advising them where and at what time to report. It is expected that the men will leave Chester possibly on a morning of September 24.

Elsewhere in this issue we are printing a copy of the "Red Card" which is to be sent to each man first.

Below we are printing the names of the first five per cent of Chester county's quota mobilized on the expected date. Five alternates have also been selected. In the event any of the first five selected fails to appear an alternate is sent in his place, however, the men selected first should be on hand since they are liable to appear in a great military offense punishable by court-martial.

THE "RED" CARD TO BE SENT TO DRAFTED MEN

By direction of the Secretary of War, you are hereby ordered to report to the office of this Local Board at _____ day of _____, 1917, for military duty and for transportation to the Army mobilization point.

From the date herein specified for you to report, you will be in the military service of the United States and you are liable for military offenses punishable by court-martial. Failure to report, with intention to evade military service, constitutes desertion, which is a capital offense in time of war. Present yourself at the precise time specified, in order that you may not begin your military record in the service of your country with a delinquency.

You will be held under the orders of this board until the hour of departure of your train. During this period the Local Board will furnish you food and lodging. If you live within one hour's travel of the office of the Local Board you may obtain permission to sleep and eat at home, but only if you fill out and forward to the office of the Local Board at once the printed application for this permission at the end of this notice.

You will not be permitted to take with you on the train anything but hand baggage. You do not need bedding or changes of clothing except as specified below: shaving accessories, comb and brush; toothbrush and toothpowder; towels; underclothing and socks; and, if you desire, changes of collars and shirts, but you will have no use for these after arrival at the mobilization camp.

Since you will not be permitted to retain any trunks after your arrival at the railroad station, the articles listed above should be brought in a hand baggage.

If you desire to do so, you may return the civilian clothes you are wearing when you arrive at the mobilization camp to your home by express or otherwise, but if you desire to keep such arrangements, it will be better to appear in civilian clothes that you do not care to keep.
