military service, constitutes desertion, which is a capital
offense in time of war. Present yourself at the precise
hour specified, in order that you may not begin your military record in the service of your country with a delinquency.

You will he held under the orders of this beard until the hour of departure of your train. During this period
the Local Board will furnish you food, and lodging. If
you live within one hour's travel of the office of the Local
Board you may obtain permission to sleep and est
at home, but only if you fill out and forward to the office of the Local Board at once the privated application
for this permission at the remission to the train anything but hand baggage. Tou do, not need, bedding or changes of clothing except as specified below.
You may take with you only the following articles: Soap;
shaving accessories: come and brush; toughfursh and
touthpowder: towels; undertothing and socks; and, if
you desire, changes of collars and shirts, but you will
have no use for these after arrival at the mobilization
camp.
