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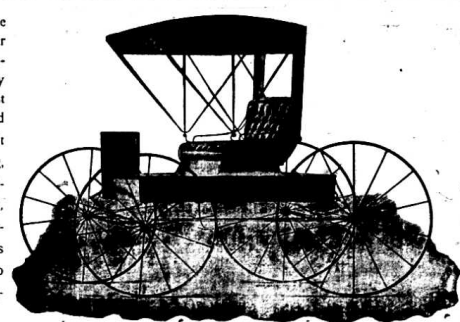

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HAGOOD'S BRIGADE.

The Battle of Beane Station - How's Mistake - How it Was Made - Theirs to Reason Why Into the Jaws of Death They Charged.

At the time Gen. Hagood came up and the whole line rushed forward. The enemy opened a deadly fire from their batteries just in front of the 21st and 25th regiments, who rushed upon them to their death.

This disposed of the left regiments of the brigade for the day. The others were the 27th on the left, the 11th in the center, and the 18th on the right. It was not till 11 o'clock that the church bells at Petersburg rang out that Sunday hour down in the valley of the shadow of death.

Next day the brigade was sent to Dunslop's farm to rest and recruit up. For several days the brigade increased from 1500 to 2500 men. There was no accident, no occurrence, no look place which delighted Col. Rion to tell.
