Description of series and its contents:

**This series consists of the records pertaining to and produced by the Wade Hampton Literary Society. The Wade Hampton Literary Society was organized in 1909 and named after Confederate Colonel Wade Hampton III (March 28, 1818-April 11, 1902) who was a Confederate cavalry leader during the American Civil War and a politician from Charleston, South Carolina. The motto was "Victory must be fought for." The official color was garnet and the flower was the red carnation.**
