try at least 8,000,000 bales are exported, and every one of these exported bales must go through the few existing compresses to be bought by the owner of the compress at its own expense, and large allowances is always made for compress charges and for tare.

Even then, when the cotton reaches England or Germany an additional reduction is made for tare, because of the weight of the compress and the tare. Thus it comes about that, first and last, by the time the cotton is sold in foreign lands the southern grower has gone to an expense of 10 per cent. in addition to the usual compress charges, and his cotton is converted into cash, and there is interminable trouble and delay about it.

IN SHORT ITEMS

HAPPENINGS OF GENERAL INTEREST GIVEN.

Gathered from the Exchanges and Condensed for Lantern Readers.

Lansing, Mich., Jan. 27.—Ex-Secretary Frank P. Glazier, of Chelsea, whose failure in December, 1907, resulted in the closing of the Chelsea Savings Bank, of which Glazier was the head, and which had on deposits about \$85,000 of state funds, was this afternoon found guilty by a jury in the federal court (Circuit Court of Appeals) of embezzling state funds.

Washington, Jan. 27.—Changes in the method of administration of the government on the suburban canal zone are recommended to Congress in a bill which was agreed upon today by the committee on Interstate and Commerce, whose members recently returned from the zone. Instead of the commission of seven now governing the zone, the bill provides for a commission of five members, one of whom shall be the chief engineer of the zone, and who shall be directly connected with the actual work of construction, but is so worded that the President is appointed to appoint the present chief engineer, as director, in addition to his position as chief engineer. The report of the committee will praise the present chief engineer, Mr. E. C. Jones, and will recommend that he be appointed to the position of chief engineer.

Hamlet, Jan. 27.—The Boyd Hotel, a four-story building, and other buildings on the Boyd Hotel site, were destroyed by a fire which broke out in the early morning. The fire was caused by a gas leak in the boiler room. The loss is estimated at \$50,000. The hotel was a total loss, and the building alone is valued at between \$15,000 and \$16,000. The hotel was owned by Mr. E. N. Rhodes and was insured for \$50,000.
