- In the President's and Dean's lists, students are listed alphabetically, along with their county and state of residence.

ROCK HILL, S.C. - The names of Winthrop University graduates and high-achieving students on the **President's** and **Dean's lists** from fall 2013 are now available on the university's web site.

In the [President's and Dean's lists](#), students are listed alphabetically, along with their county and state of residence.

To be named to the **President's list**, students must have earned a 4.0 grade point average during the semester. To be named to the **Dean's list**, students must have earned a 3.5 or better GPA. Students also must have completed 12 semester hours to letter-grade courses for the semester.
