Rock Hill, Jan. 2--Concluding a two-weeks' Christmas holiday, Winthrop students will return tonight to the South Carolina College for Women which, now in its 61st year, will observe Founder's Day this month.

The 1,546 students will resume a full schedule of classes on Friday morning at the college which, founded in 1886 by Dr. David Bancroft Johnson, now boasts alumni totalling more than 15,000.

The first semester examination period will begin January 17, college officials announced. Second semester will begin January 27.
