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






Picture Books are a little different...






They are an interactive art form— performance art— incomplete until in the hands of a reader.

It's not.


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True story:


Theodore Geisel, Dr. Seuss, was at a cocktail party where he met a brain surgeon.

Here's what you should not do:

Tell a common theme

(friendship, new sibling, new pet, new school, feelings, family, holidays, etc.)

Create a tired tale

(An old-fashioned memory)

Create something that's been done before

(a gazillion times)

Be didactic

(teach a lesson: that's a big no-no!)

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








Here is my publishing journey in a nutshell...




Day 1: Heard how tough it was.

I GOT MY 1st PICTURE BOOK CONTRACT!!!







And a 2nd!
