Three Winthrop college faculty members, Dr. Celesta Wine, Dr. Griffith T. Pugh, and Dr. Dorothy Jones, have been promoted from associate to full professors, Pres. Henry R. Sims announced.

Doctor Wine, professor of English, came to Winthrop in September 1941. A native Virginian, she received degrees from the following schools: B.A., Manchester college; B.D., Juniata college; M.A. and Ph.D., University of Chicago. She also studied at the British Museum.

Doctor Pugh of Rock Hill, professor of English, began his work at Winthrop in September 1938. The son of the late Dr. Griffith T. Pugh, for many years professor of mathematics at Winthrop, Professor Pugh received his B.A. and M.A. degrees at the University of S. C., and his Ph.D. at Vanderbilt university.

Doctor Jones, professor of sociology, also a Virginian, has been at Winthrop since September 1943. She received her degrees at the following schools: B.A., Randolph-Macon college; M.S.S.W. William and Mary School of Social Work; and Ph.D., University of N. C.
