ROCK HILL, S.C. - The job of directing a play - even a play with only one act - is not without its challenges. But during the Department of Theatre and Dance's Spring One-Act Festival, theatre majors like Wesley Henry learn how to overcome those issues.

Henry, who will direct David Ives' "Time Flies" during the April 8-10 festival, worked closely with his stage manager to coordinate rehearsal schedules around his actors' availability. Henry also learned how to channel his own vision for "Time Flies" through his performers.

"I really enjoy being able to show my ideas about a play through the actors," said Henry, a native of Lyman, S.C.

The **festival**, which is the culmination of student work in the class THRA 431: Directing II, will include performances April 8-10. The plays, divided into Groups A and B, will be performed separately. Performances of Group A's four plays will be April 8 at 8 p.m. and April 9 at 2 p.m. Group B plays will be performed April 9 at 8 p.m. and April 10 at 2 p.m. All performances will be held in Johnson Studio Theatre.

Since spring 1955, when the **Department of Theatre and Dance** began doing one-act plays, the department has presented more than 600 one-act productions. The popularity of the spring festival prompted the creation of the Fall One-Act Festival.

"Roll Over, Beethoven" by David Ives Directed by Jamie Bellah (Charleston, S.C.)

Group B

"Reluctant Prophets" by Keith J. Powell Directed by Cecily Bigham (Merrimac, Mass.)

"The Brute" by Eric Bentley (from Anton Chekhov) Directed by Melissa O'Mara (Goose Creek, S.C.)

"I'm Not Stupid" by David E. Rodriguez Directed by Norman Burt (Mauldin, S.C.)

"Time Flies" by David Ives Directed by Wesley Henry (Lyman, S.C.)

The **Spring One-Act Festival** is part of Rock Hill's 48th annual **Come-See-Me Festival**. Seating is limited, and no late seating will be permitted after performances begin. **Plays contain adult language and situations.**
