ROCK HILL, S.C. - An exhibition opening in [Winthrop University Galleries](#) will showcase the work of senior undergraduate Bachelor of Fine Arts degree candidates and offer fine arts students exhibition experience in the gallery setting.

Opening April 19 in the [Rutledge and Patrick Galleries](#), the **Senior Undergraduate B.F.A. Exhibition** is a new exhibition designed to enrich the fine arts student experience at the senior level, according to Assistant Gallery Director Karen Derksen. **Winthrop University Galleries** will host an opening reception on April 23 from 6:30-8 p.m. in Rutledge Gallery.

The **B.F.A. Exhibition** will run April 19-May 7, with an extra viewing on May 8 after convocation from 12:30-2 p.m.

The **Galleries** will continue to focus on student-artists with the "**Making in the Real World**" lecture series. **Angela Bubash**, a studio artist and educator, and **Amy Tavern**, a jewelry maker and resident artist at the Penland School of Crafts in Penland, N.C., will talk to students and the community about their professional experiences and work on April 22 at 8 p.m. in Rutledge Building 119.
