ROCK HILL, S.C. – Winthrop University's [College of Business Administration](#) will welcome **First Lieutenant Franklin Ladson** on Tuesday, April 3, to speak as part of the college's Leadership Series.

Ladson, a 2009 Winthrop graduate, is currently the director of **Operation, INOSC East (Integrated Network Operation Security Center)/SCO Deputy Flight Commander; 83 Network Operation Squadron**. He is stationed at [Langley Air Force Base](#) in Hampton, Va.

Ladson oversees network administration which is valued at \$479 million and supports 356,000 users. He manages **De-3conflicts AF Network Operation activities** with aerospace operations and executes emergency recovery plans for mission assurance. Ladson also manages 130 military and civilian personnel.

His presentation will show a young leader's perspective on leadership preparation and the steps he went through to prepare for his leadership role and his first overseas leadership assignment.
