ROCK HILL, S.C. – **James "Jimmie" Williamson '80 '85** will join the Winthrop University's **Board of Trustees** on July 1 as the alumni representative. He was selected by fellow alumni during a three-month online election, which ended March 20.

Williamson of Cheraw, S.C., is the chief human capital officer at **Agape Senior**, a faith-based provider of long-term care for senior adults. He retired after 28 years in higher education, having served as president of two S.C. technical colleges and as a faculty member or administrator at five colleges/universities including Winthrop.

He earned a bachelor's degree in visual arts in 1980 and a M.Ed. in 1985, both from Winthrop, and then a Ph.D. from the University of South Carolina in 1994. Williamson has served on the Alumni Association Executive Board, received the **Alumni Association Professional Achievement Award** in 2001 and joined the **D.B. Johnson Society** as an inaugural member.
