## Health Education Professor Earns MCHES Certification

## **Quick Facts**

Shelley Hamill, associate professor of health education, has been certified as a Master Certified Health Education Specialist.

Hamill has taught health education for more than 27 years.



ROCK HILL, S.C. - Shelley Hamill, associate professor of health education, is among the first group to earn the certification as a Master Certified Health Education Specialist.

The newly created advanced-level certification, awarded by the **National Commission for Health Education Credentialing, Inc.**, signifies that **Hamill** has met the national standards for individual health education practitioners. The **MCHES certification** attests to health educators' knowledge and understanding of the health education areas of responsibility at an advanced level and assists employers in identifying qualified

health education practitioners.

**Hamill** earned her Ph.D. in education at Walden University, her M.Ed. in health education at the University of North Carolina-Charlotte and her B.A. in physical education at Pfeiffer University. She has more than 27 years of experience teaching at elementary, middle and collegiate levels. She served as cho-chair of the Health and Safety Curriculum Standards for the state of South Carolina. **Hamill** is the recipient of the Governor's Award from North Carolina for her service in the fight against HIV/AIDS, and she was recognized by the U.S. Surgeon General for her work with tribal communities on the issues of HIV/AIDS, STDs and substance abuse. She also has been recognized twice as a "Woman of Achievement" by Winthrop's Division of Student Life.

In addition, **Hamill** received the Health Education Professor of the Year award from the S.C. Association for the Advancement of Health Education in 2000 and 2010.
