Rock Hill, Jan. 29--An education course, carrying three semester hours credit, will be offered by Winthrop college to college graduates in York county and surrounding areas, beginning Wednesday, February 5. Dr. Sadie Gogg^ans, professor of education, will teach the course, Advanced Educational Psychology--Human Growth and Development.

Planned for one weekly meeting for 15 weeks, the course) ~~will begin with a registration and organization~~ will begin with a meeting for registration and organization, at 6 p.m., February 5, in Kinard hall. Unless 20 persons enroll at that time, the course will not be offered.

Actual class periods of two and one-half hours are scheduled to begin on Tuesday, February 11, at 6 p.m., and will be held each Tuesday following for 15 weeks.

The college will charge a \$15 tuition fee for the course. An additional fee of \$5 will be required of those who have not already registered at Winthrop college during this school year.
