Rock Hill, Jan. 30--Charles Weidman, dancer and choreographer, will bring his company of ~~11~~ 10 modern dancers to Winthrop college for a concert on Monday, at 8 p.m., in the main auditorium.

The program will include four numbers: David and Goliath, "A House Divided--", Jesse James, and "And Daddy Was a Fireman".

Peter Hamilton, leading male dancer in the group, will perform the dance, Jesse James, of which he is also the choreographer. Without musical accompaniment, the dance is performed with ~~musical~~ narration based on a poem by W. R. Benet.

Dancers in the group, besides Weidman and Hamilton, include Saida Gerrard, Betty Osgood, Betts Lee, Felicia Conde, Jane Burroughs, Carl Morris, Robert Herget, Robert Crawley, and Emily Frankel. Freda Miller is the pianist.

The appearance of the Charles Weidman dance group is the sixth event in Winthrop's artists course series of this year.
