# Prestigious Dance Festival Selects Instructor's Piece for Performance

ROCK HILL, S.C. — A dance piece by [Winthrop University Instructor of Dance Meg Schriffen](#) was recently chosen for the competitive Southeast American College Dance Festival, the first time in nearly a decade that a Winthrop faculty member's work was selected for a performance there.

Twenty-two dance majors from Winthrop represented the university at the festival, which was held in Tampa, Fla., earlier this month. The students had the opportunity to take daily classes related to dance, attend concerts and perform at the event.

More than 40 dances were submitted and adjudicated by a professional panel of dance experts, including **Robert Moses**, **Debra Cash** and **Sarah Hook**. Schriffen's piece, entitled "**Stirrings of Consciousness**," was one of the 12 selected to be performed at the prestigious event, the Final Gala Concert.
