ROCK HILL, S.C. — Winthrop University's Department of Theatre and Dance will offer audiences a lively and entertaining mixture of one act-plays with the Spring One-Act Play Festival, opening April 17 in Johnson Studio Theatre.

The festival's 10 plays, divided into Groups A and B, are a hands-on learning experience for students: they are all student-produced and -designed with student actors as well as advanced theatre students at the director's helm.

Group A plays include:

#### "The Future is In Your Tiny Hands" by Jonathan Rand Director: Kate Meyers (Forest Hill, Md.)

Two elementary-school students square off in a debate for student body president. Hot topics include tater tots, cootie prevention and kickball rosters.

#### "The Blueberry Hill Accord" by Daryl Watson

Director: Jasmine Gunter (Columbia, S.C.)

A high school student looks to end a nearly decade-long friendship.

#### "Amateurs" by David Auburn

Director: Elliot Emigh (Fort Mill, S.C.)

A woman whose father's political career was ruined years earlier by an attack ad confronts the politician responsible.

#### "A Couple of Bimbos Sittin' Around Talking" by Richard Vetere

Director: Brittany Mayo (Rock Hill, S.C.)

Three women waiting on their boyfriends decide to fix up a less-than-glamorous cousin. While the cousin is at first off-put by the tight clothes and hairstyles, she learns not to judge a book by its cover.

#### "The M Word" by Alan Ball

Director: Melinda Longtin (Rock Hill, S.C.)

A couple discusses if they are a good match or not in marriage.

#### "Check Please: Take 3!" by Jonathan Rand

Director: Kimberly Cumming (West Columbia, S.C.) Two best friends give blind-dating another disastrous try.

Director: Jonathon Long (Catawba, S.C.)

Shaken by the death of a childhood best friend, a man recalls their friendship while packing for the funeral.

#### "The Ex" by Geoffrey Scheer

Director: Jonathan Hoskins (Rock Hill, S.C.)

An ex-girlfriend threatens to put a damper on two friends' Atlantic City vacation.

#### "Designer Genes" by Kent R. Brown

Director: Jarrod Bennett (Huntersville, N.C.)

A couple who lost a son in a tragic accident desperately contact the cloning service Designer Genes, Inc.

#### "Dog Lovers" by S.W. Senek

Director: Emily Cupit (Hilton Head, S.C.)

A dog lover discovers the significant other she met through a dating site may love her dog more than her.
