Sneak Previews Part of Create Carolina's Weekend Offerings

Quick Facts

ROCK HILL, S.C. - Film buffs can catch sneak previews of two upcoming films this weekend at Winthrop University. Both are free events.

On Friday, May 18, the film "**A Beach Party at the Threshold of Hell**" will show at 8 p.m. at **Tillman Auditorium**. This independently made dark comedy is directed by Jonny Gillette. Among the actors are Chandler Parker and Jonathan Davidson, who are guest artists of the **Create Carolina Arts Festival** currently being held on the Winthrop campus.

The plot of the film is based on the concept of "New America" in the year 2097, two decades after a nuclear apocalypse. Tex Kennedy, two robotic ex-Secret Service agents, and a mythical female cannibal journey to find a famously dangerous area known as the "Threshold of Hell" to gain access to a radio tower to unite the survivors of the apocalypse.

The film's Emmy-winning cinematographer, Cameron Pearce, will be on hand for a master class at 4:30 p.m. Friday in **Tillman Auditorium** to talk about how to make a film and television seminar. Pearce also will be on hand for the film screening.

On Saturday, May 19, the documentary "**A Shot in the Dark**" to air in June on HBO will be shown at 8 p.m. in **Tillman Auditorium**. HBO's "Entourage" star Adrian Grenier directed this documentary along with Jonathan Davidson, which chronicles Grenier's years-long search for his real father, John Dunbar, who left when Grenier was still a baby. "**A Shot in the Dark**" debuted at the Toronto Film Festival in 2006.

The film screenings bring an end to the first week of **Create Carolina Arts Festival**. The **festival** is a three-week multidisciplinary intensive arts experience offering three hours of university credit and the expectation for college-age students and adults to participate in production of both the play and staged reading through classes and workshops.
