Rock Hill, Feb. 7--The National Symphony orchestra of Washington, under the direction of Hans Kindler, will give a concert at Winthrop college on February 14(Friday), at 8 p.m. in the main auditorium.

Mr. Kindler, who founded the orchestra, has been its conductor since its first season 16 years ago. They have appeared in Rock Hill several times but next week's concert, presented through Winthrop's 1946-47 artists course series, will be the first appearance here since before the war.

The program will include music by Mozart, Franck, Khachaturyan, and Rimsk-Korsakov. Tickets will be on sale at the box office.
