The award recognizes an employee who exemplifies Winthrop's core values, goes above and beyond to do great work, and sets an example for other staff members to follow.

President Dan Mahony also honored two employees – Chrissy Catoe, associate director of development, and Wes Love, project manager in facilities management - with the Winthrop Award of Excellence, which is a new prestigious honor created to recognize individuals who have excelled in implementing the Winthrop Plan, the university's strategic plan. Award selection is based on the individual nominee's noteworthy contributions to the realization of one or more of the major goals of the Winthrop Plan.
