YORK NEWS BEST ORCHARD COVER CROP

Items From The Yorkville Enquirer of More or Less Interest to Chester County People. Heard a member of the legislature say not long ago that he would certainly not vote for a certain bill...

There are many different kinds of winter cover crops that will do well in orchards. The leader is probably a mixture of vetch with rye, wheat or oats. On comparatively poor soil, a mixture of alfalfa and rye or 20 pounds of hairy vetch will make an excellent winter cover crop.

When using crimson clover instead of vetch, use eight to ten pounds of the clover seed to a bushel of oats or half a bushel of rye. The clover should be substituted for crimson clover in the upper part of the South where it succeeds well.

Another excellent winter cover crop particularly for the lower South is the cowpea, sown by itself at the rate of 20 pounds per acre. This is a particularly good cover crop for pean growers.

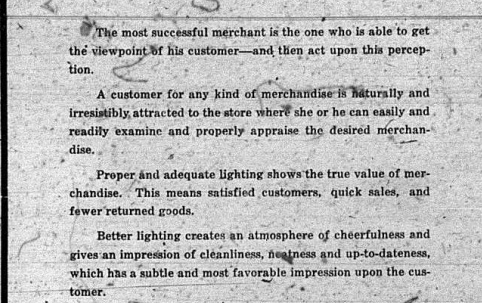
