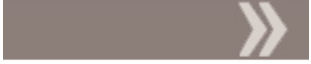

ROCK HILL, S.C. — The **Ida Jane Dacus Library's Renovation Celebration** will be one for the books on Sept. 4 with food, music, contests and fun.

The **free event is open to the public and will run from 11 a.m.-3:30 p.m.** It marks one of the first glimpses the public has had into the newly renovated library.

The first 25 participants will receive free T-shirts. Students gain raffle tickets via participation in games, with the **grand prize winner taking home an e-reader.** The event will also feature food, live music, games, demos, exhibits and contests.

The library underwent extensive renovations and improvements over the summer, sparked by a survey in which hundreds of students provided feedback on what they would like to see in the library. Students have been greeted with **group study rooms, technobooths** and an **information commons**, a combination of both the circulation and reference desks. The library will also move to **24-hour access Sunday-Thursday, beginning Sept. 3.**
