the 1st Cavalry Division, composed of 100 white and 100 negro troops, is being sent to Camp Sheridan rifle range 16 miles from here, according to information given out at Camp Sheridan headquarters today. The movement will start Thursday or Friday, it was said, depending on moon arrangements can be made.
