Japanese Tale Retells Story of Double Crime

ROCK HILL, S.C. - Winthrop men's basketball players **Torrell Martin** and **Taj McCullough** are among the students cast in the Winthrop University production "**Rashomon**" on Oct. 25-29.

Set in 12th-century Japan, "**Rashomon**" retells the story of a double crime from the perspective of the participants and a witness. The contradictory accounts of these events explore the nature of truth and the conflicting world of reality and illusion. The play, directed by Professor of Theatre **Annie-Laurie Wheat**, is based on stories by Ryunosuke Akutagawa and Akiri Kurosawa's film masterpiece "**Rashomon**."

The productions begin at 8 p.m. on Oct. 25-28 and at 2 p.m. on Oct. 29 in **Johnson Studio Theatre**.
