ROCK HILL, S.C. - Winthrop University's **Department of Theatre and Dance** will present "**Summer and Smoke**," one of Tennessee Williams' most respected plays, from Oct. 4-8.

The play, a delicate tragedy of missed romantic possibilities, will be directed by **Russell Luke**, theatre instructor. It is a simple love story of a puritanical Southern girl in love since childhood with the highly unpuritanical boy next door. The play becomes a conflict of opposites as the two, because of different attitudes about life, are driven further apart.

"**Summer and Smoke**" contains some of Williams' most poetic and dramatic writing.

Performances will begin at 8 p.m. Oct. 4-7 and at 2 p.m. on Oct. 8 in **Johnson Theatre**. The cost is \$8 with a Winthrop I.D. and \$10 general admission.
