Quick Facts

- To use the list of Graduates, type in the last name of a student or choose to view graduates by degree, major or place of residence by city, county and state.
- In the President's and Dean's lists, students are listed alphabetically, along with their county and state of residence.

ROCK HILL, S.C. - The names of Winthrop University graduates and high-achieving students on the President's and Dean's lists from spring 2011 are now available on the university's website at www.winthrop.edu/gradlist.

To locate students, visit **Graduate list**. To use the list of Graduates, type in the last name of a student or choose to view graduates by degree, major or place of residence by city, county and state. Most of the boxes offer a pull-down menu of choices to select.

In the **President's** and **Dean's lists**, students are listed alphabetically, along with their county and state of residence.

To be named to the President's list, students must have earned a 4.0 grade point ratio during the semester. To be named to the Dean's list, students must have earned a 3.5 or better GPR. Students also must have completed 12 semester hours to letter-grade courses for the semester.
