# ETV Presents Preview Screening of Ken Burns' World War II Documentary

## Quick Facts

- ETV will screen Ken Burns' World War II documentary "The War" on Winthrop's campus.
- The screening will take place over a seven-day period.

ROCK HILL, S.C. - ETV presents a special preview screening of "The War," the seven-part documentary series directed and produced by critically-acclaimed filmmaker Ken Burns. "The War" explores the history and horror of the Second World War from the perspective of veterans and citizens from four American towns: Waterbury, Conn.; Mobile, Ala.; Sacramento, Calif.; and Luverne, Minn.

The free hour-long preview, which is open to the public and features clips from all seven episodes, takes place on Tuesday, Sept. 18 at 7 p.m. at the Winthrop University's **Plowden Auditorium**.

"The War" will air in full beginning Sunday, Sept. 23 according to the following schedule:

- Tuesday, Oct. 2; 8-10:30 p.m. – Episode Seven: "A World Without War"
