ROCK HILL, S.C. - Three Winthrop University students will race through "**The Complete Works of Shakespeare (Abridged)**" in less than two hours during productions next week.

Students **David Fichter** of Midlothian, Va., **Brian Jones** of Columbia, S.C., and **Ricky Watson** of Jacksonville, Fla., will appear as Romeo, Juliet, Hamlet, Ophelia and other memorable characters created by the Bard of Avon. In this crown-throwing, wig-swapping play directed by student Stephen Seay of Spartanburg, S.C., anything could happen with all of the costume changes and gender-switching roles.
