ROCK HILL, SOUTH CAROLINA — Four Winthrop University students and alumni were selected as scholarship winners by the **Charlotte-area Society for Human Resource Management (SHRM)**.

Five area students were selected, with four of the winners having Winthrop ties. The students are:
