Most of the boxes offer a pull-down menu of choices to select.

To be named to the [President's list](#), students must have earned a 4.0 grade point ratio during the semester. To be named to the [Dean's list](#), students must have earned a 3.5 or better GPR. Students also must have completed 12 semester hours to letter-grade courses for the semester.
