Prior to joining Wachovia and Wells Fargo Securities, Vitner was an economist for Barnett Banks in Jacksonville, Florida, for nearly nine years.

Vitner's commentary has been featured in the New York Times, Wall Street Journal, Bloomberg and many other publications. He also is a frequent guest on CNBC, CNN, National Public Radio and the NewsHour with Jim Lehrer.

A native of Atlanta, Georgia, Vitner holds a B.B.A. in economics from the University of Georgia, an M.B.A. from the University of North Florida and has completed further graduate work in economics at the University of Florida. Vitner also completed the National Association of Business Economics (NABE) Advanced Training in Economics Program at Carnegie-Mellon University.
