He will be recognized by the Historical Committee at the Nov. 8 annual meeting in Greensboro, N.C., for his work "**An Unbroken Chain: The History of Coats Baptist Church, 1910-2010**," which was published in 2010.

**Faulkner** has published numerous articles on North Carolina history and politics and taught history for 21 years at Campbell University prior to his move to Winthrop. Faulkner has been an academic librarian for more than 30 years in Tennessee, West Virginia, and in both North and South Carolina.
