ROCK HILL, SOUTH CAROLINA - The world's top disc golfer will be competing for the **Disc Golf Grand Slam** and the chance to earn a share of the \$50,000 purse when Winthrop hosts the **2015 US Disc Golf Championship** Oct. 7-10 at the **Winthrop Recreation Area**.

While traditional golf's **Jordan Spieth** and tennis great **Serena Williams** both captured the sporting world's attention this year with attempts at capturing a Grand Slam title, both came up short. **Paul McBeth**, disc golf's biggest star, now has his chance to complete **Disc Golf's Grand Slam**.

Tee times for the first and second rounds on Oct. 7 and 8 will be at 8 a.m. while the third and final rounds on Oct. 9 and 10 will begin at 1 p.m. Single day tickets are priced at \$10 and a VIP ticket for the four days is \$25. Winthrop students with valid ID cards will be admitted for free.
