In addition to tailgating on Saturday, students can participate during the week in a student talent show, a lip sync competition, a car smash and a step show.

On Saturday, Nov. 12, the fun starts at 11 a.m. on the south lawn at [Winthrop Coliseum](#) as the [Lloyd Dobler Effect](#) gives a concert. Alumni are welcome to stop by a booth hosted by the [Winthrop Alumni Association](#) – at noon outside the Coliseum for burgers and hot dogs.

At 4 p.m., tailgaters can cheer on the Eagles as they face Eastern Kentucky University. Later Saturday evening, the [DiGiorgio Student Union](#) will offer two free showings of "Kung Fu Panda 2" at 7 p.m. and 9:30 p.m. at Dina's Place in the [DiGiorgio Campus Center](#).

Also Saturday, the highly anticipated **National Pan-hellenic Council Homecoming Step Show** will begin at 8 p.m. Nov. 12 in [Byrnes Auditorium](#). Tickets are \$7 in advance and \$15 at the door.
