Tim Sease Elected President of Winthrop University Alumni Association

Quick Facts

- Sease is currently president and chief executive officer of First Southeast Investor Services headquartered in Charleston.
- He will head the 19-member Alumni Association Executive Board for a two-year term ending in June 2007.

ROCK HILL, S.C. - The **Winthrop University Alumni Association** has elected **Tim B. Sease '87** of Charleston, S.C., as president of its Executive Board. As the **Alumni Board president**, Sease hopes to promote Winthrop University around the state and region as one of the premier destinations in the Southeast for higher education.

Sease is currently president and chief executive officer of **First Southeast Investor Services** headquartered in Charleston. **Sease** holds NASD Series 7, 63, 65 and 24 Securities Licenses as well as the State of South Carolina Life, Accident, and Health Insurance License. He also is a CFP and a Chartered Financial Consultant (ChFC). Prior to joining First Southeast, he was president of Home Financial Services in Rock Hill. Sease is a 1987 graduate of Winthrop, where he earned a degree in communications and a minor in business administration.

Martie H. Curran, assistant vice president and executive director of Alumni Relations, said, "We are pleased to have Tim Sease serve as president of the Alumni Board at Winthrop University. His commitment and leadership will be a great asset to this association, and his experience will help us to further our promotion of the excellent academic programs and rich history the university offers."

Sease will head the **19-member Alumni Association Executive Board** for a two-year term ending in June 2007. In addition to serving on the alumni executive board, Sease is on the Trident United Way Finance Committee and is a member of the Charleston Chamber of Commerce and The Country Club of Charleston. He also serves Mt. Pleasant Presbyterian Church on the Budget and Finance Committee and as a deacon.
