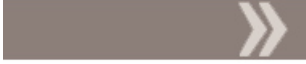

In addition to his medical career, Carson has authored eight books and sat on the board of directors of numerous entities, including Kellogg Company, Costco Wholesale Corporation, the Academy of Achievement, and is an Emeritus Fellow of the Yale Corporation, the governing body of Yale University.

The Dec. 2 event begins at 2 p.m. at the [Winthrop Coliseum](#), with doors opening at 11 a.m.

General parking will be at the Coliseum. Campus police officers will direct traffic.
