Scope and Content Note: **The South Carolina Food Service Association Records consist of historical statements, constitutions and by-laws, annual, officer and committee reports, minutes of the executive board, correspondence, financial records, membership records, newsletters, handbooks, photographs, newspaper clippings and other records. There are records relating to the regional and national school food service associations and to the 1963 International Congress on Home Economics. The South Carolina School Food Service Association was founded in 1954 and was created to develop high standards for school food service programs in South Carolina, in promoting legislation designed to foster adequate school food service programs, and in promoting interest in the recruitment and training of school food service personnel.**
