Winthrop University's Department of Theatre and Dance's fall 2013 showcase includes pieces choreographed by students **Shelby Scott** (Rock Hill, S.C.); **Shelby Mosher** (Baton Rouge, La.); **Nia Harris** (Columbia, S.C.); **Lustra Miller** (Spartanburg, S.C.); **Nikeshia Nelson** (Columbia, S.C.); **Mackenzie Elder** (Lyman, S.C.); and **Amanda Floyd** (Lugoff, S.C.)

Other aspects of the show, including lighting, music, technical design and costume design, are also student-produced.

The director for the show is Assistant Professor of Dance Valerie Ifill, who joined Winthrop in her current role after serving two years as an adjunct faculty member. She said the students have worked extremely hard on this upcoming showcase.
