Scope and Content Note: **Carolyn Essig Frederick (ca1906-2000) was a civic leader and member of the South Carolina House of Representatives for Greenville County from 1967-1976. The collection consists of newsletters, correspondence, speeches, clippings, financial and other records, relating to Frederick's work as a state legislator, including service on committees. Subjects include criminal justice, child protection, education, crime prevention and prison reform, health care, nursing education, American Association of University Women (AAUW), transportation, and the political affairs of Greenville County.**
