Scope and Content: **The Marlboro County Extension Homemakers Council Records consist of minutes of meetings, yearly reports of Council, correspondence, records relating to governance, financial records, membership lists, attendance lists, programs notes, newsletters, yearly calendars, newspaper clippings, photographs, scrapbooks, and records relating to laws, regulations, workshop training sessions, council projects, awards won by council members, and other educational material. This collection is a useful source on farm living and women's roles in Marlboro County. Information on the Extension Homemakers' Council begins in 1921 although there is mention made of a Home Extension Agent as early as 1918. For most, series records are incomplete.**
