Description of series and its contents:

This collection contains replications of different uniforms and clothing items worn by the students of Winthrop during the early 1900's. The replications were made by Winthrop Alumna Alison Boulton in 2013.

1	1	BROWN VELVET AND COTTON DRESSING GOWN -Made by Alison Boulton, it contains the dressing gown and a brown velvet belt that would have been worn in the early 1900's.	2013
2	1	COOKING SCHOOL UNIFORM - Made by Alison Boulton, it contains the cooking school uniform worn between 1900 and 1907 which includes the cap, apron, and sleeve covers.	2013
3	1	1899 BLUE WOOL UNIFORM - Made by Alison Boulton, it contains the uniform worn in 1899 which includes an Elton jacket, an antique cotton shirtwaist, and a 5-panel wool skirt.	2013
4	1	1907 BLUE WOOL UNIFORM - Made by Alison Boulton, it contains the uniform worn in 1907 which includes a 4-button jacket with pocket flaps, a white "pigeon-front" shirtwaist, and a 7-panel wool skirt.	2013
5	1	1910 BLUE WOOL UNIFORM - Made by Alison Boulton, it contains the uniform worn in 1910 which included a blue and white shirtwaist, and a 7-panel wool skirt.	2013
6	1	CORSET - Made by Alison Boulton in 2013, it is a replication of the corsets women would have worn in the early 1900's.	2013
7	1	EARLY 20 TH CENTURY BLACK STOCKINGS - A pair of black stockings that are similar to the ones worn with the Winthrop uniform.	c. 1910
8	1	BELTS - Made by Alison Boulton, it contains one blue belt with a gold buckle, and two black belts one with a silver buckle and one with a brass buckle that would have been worn between 1899 and 1910.	2013
9	1	COLLAR - Contains a stiff white collar with a flower design around the bottom edge.	c. 1900
10	1	TIES - Made by Alison Boulton, it contains a solid black tie, a black and white striped tie, and a black bowtie with white polka dots that would have been worn with the uniform between 1899 and 1907.	2013
11	1	BOOTS -Contains an original pair of black boots that were part of the Winthrop uniform. They belonged to Laureen Young.	c. 1900
