### BIOGRAPHY

#### REBECCA WILSON CLARK SNYDER



Rebecca Wilson Clark Snyder was born on August 16, 1899 in Laurens, SC. Her mother was Anna Eliza Bozeman Hart Clark (1859-1930), and was of Irish descent. Her father, Colin McKenzie Clark (1873-1927), was of English and Scottish descent. Rebecca graduated from Laurens City Schools in 1915, and proceeded to Winthrop College for her teaching degree. She graduated from Winthrop in 1919. She would go on to teach in Little River, Gastonia, Hendersonville, Laurens, Columbia, and Walhalla. Rebecca Clark married Theodore Snyder, a builder and a farmer, in 1931. With Mr. Snyder she had four sons, Theodore, Jr., John, Charles, and Henry. She died on April 2, 1990, at the age of 90 in Greenville, South Carolina, where she lived after the death of her husband in 1970.
